IT IS ORDERED continuing this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Disciplinary Commission shall
serve a copy of its October 17, 2008 Report on respondent at her
address in Tucson, Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent shall have thirty days
after service of the Report to file a petition for review. An
original and seven copies of the petition for review shall be filed
with the Clerk of this Court. A copy of the petition shall also be
served on the State Bar and the disciplinary clerk. The form and
contents of the petition shall comply with Rule 59(c) and (d), Rules
of the Supreme Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the State Bar shall file a response to the petition for review within thirty days of the service of the petition. A copy of the response shall also be served on the disciplinary clerk. The form and contents of the response shall comply with Rule 59(f). The State Bar shall serve a copy of the response on respondent at her Tucson address.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the matter will be considered by the Court in due course after the petition and response have been filed or, if no petition is filed, after the time for filing has passed.
