**O R D E R**

The following action was taken by the Supreme Court of the State of Arizona on May 20, 2010, in regard to the above-referenced cause:

ORDERED: Petition for Review = GRANTED.

FURTHER ORDERED: The case shall be set for oral argument.

FURTHER ORDERED: The parties may file simultaneous supplemental briefs, not to exceed 20 pages in length, no later than 20 days from the date of this Court's Minute Letter.

FURTHER ORDERED: That the Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance is invited to file an Amicus Curiae Brief.

FURTHER ORDERED: Request for Attorneys' Fees [Appellants American Standard Insurance et al] = CONTINUED.

Counsel shall be advised of the date and time of oral argument at such time as the hearing date is determined.

Filing of a supplemental brief is permissive rather than mandatory. This order should not be construed as an invitation to repeat the contents of the Petition for Review, the Response, or any Reply. Lack of a supplemental brief shall not be considered an admission that the position of the opposing party or parties should prevail.

The Clerk of the Court of Appeals, Division Two, Tucson, shall forward the remaining record (if any exists outside the electronic record) to the Clerk of the Supreme Court.
