Laws 2003, Chapter 200, sections 1 and 3, authorized the Arizona Supreme Court to establish a fee on superior court filings to fund the Arizona Lengthy Trial Fund and to designate that the additional fees not be imposed in cases that require minimal use of court resources or in which the opportunity for trial by jury is not afforded. Additionally, section 13 of the enactment provided for the repeal of the fee on December 31, 2013.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that to promote operational efficiency, the clerk of the superior court shall cease collection of the Arizona Lengthy Trial Fund Fee at the close of business December 27, 2013.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Arizona Code of Judicial Administration § 5-109(C) is suspended until further order. All other provisions of § 5-109 as adopted, remain unchanged and in effect.
