The Supreme Court, having administrative supervision over all courts of the state pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, periodically conducts reviews and audits of court operations.

The Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2011-43 on May 2, 2011, ordering administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Ajo Justice Court be assumed by the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Pima County.

The Ajo Justice Court has made significant improvements in case and financial processing, including backlog reductions. The Presiding Judge of Superior Court in Pima County confirms that her continued administrative oversight of this court is no longer warranted and recommends that administrative authority be returned to the Ajo Justice Court, effective January 1, 2013. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2011-43 be rescinded, effective on January 1, 2013.
