PRO TEMPORE ORDER  
No. 2012 - 39

The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Santa Cruz County has requested the appointment of a judge pro tempore to assist that court with the processing of cases. Therefore, pursuant to Ariz. Const. Art. VI, § 31 and A.R.S. § 12-141 et seq.,

IT IS ORDERED that Mary Helen Maley, State Bar # 011666, is appointed judge pro tempore to serve the Superior Court in Santa Cruz County for a term beginning July 1, 2012, and ending June 30, 2013.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mary Helen Maley shall perform judicial duties authorized by A.R.S. § 12-144 as assigned by the presiding judge. This appointment is conditioned upon the approval of the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the agreement by the appointee to serve without compensation or benefits, as provided in A.R.S. § 12-142(C).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mary Helen Maley may perform duties of a judge authorized by A.R.S. § 25-121 et seq. and A.R.S. § 12-2222 without specific assignment by the presiding judge and subject to agreement by the appointee to perform these duties without public compensation or benefits above her established salary as a justice of the peace.
