PRO TEMPORE ORDER
No. 2012 - 51

On June 27, 2012 by Pro Tempore Order No. 2012-42, Commissioner Denise D. Gaumont was appointed as a judge pro tempore to assist the court with the processing of cases for a term ending June 30, 2013. Commissioner Gaumont will retire from her position on October 1, 2012. Commissioner Gaumont presided over the criminal trial of the case of State of Arizona v. Vincent Arroyo, Jr., No. S1400CR201000313. The trial concluded on September 20, 2012. Sentencing is scheduled for October 19, 2012. Therefore, pursuant to Ariz. Const. Art. VI, § 31 and A.R.S. § 12-141 et seq.,

IT IS ORDERED that Denise D. Gaumont is appointed judge pro tempore to complete the case of State of Arizona v. Vincent Arroyo, Jr., No. S1400CR201000313 with a term beginning upon the entry of this Order and ending no later than December 31, 2012.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Denise D. Gaumont shall perform judicial duties authorized by A.R.S. § 12-144 as assigned by the presiding judge. Compensation for services shall be at a rate agreed upon by the parties and this appointment is conditional upon approval of the Yuma County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141. The Superior Court in Yuma County shall obtain appropriate funding from whatever source for any compensation due to said appointee pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-142(C) and A.R.S. § 12-143 for service as a judge pro tempore.
