PRO TEMPORE ORDER
No. 2012 - 56

The Chief Judge of the Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, has requested the appointment of the Honorable Daniel A. Barker, formerly a judge of that court and now retired, to serve as a judge pro tempore in that court to aid and assist in the consideration and disposition of a calendar in February, 2013. Therefore, pursuant to Article 6, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Daniel A. Barker is appointed to serve as a judge pro tempore in the Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, beginning February 1, 2013, and ending February 28, 2013.

While serving as a judge in the Court of Appeals, Division One, the Honorable Daniel A. Barker shall have all of the powers and duties of a judge of the Court of Appeals. These powers and duties shall extend beyond the period of this assignment for the purpose of hearing and determining any proceeding necessary to a final determination of a cause heard in whole or in part during the period of this assignment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this assignment is conditioned upon the agreement by the above-named judge to serve in Division One of the Arizona Court of Appeals for any matters designated and to do so for no additional compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise, as provided in A.R.S. §12-146(C).
