Dear Mr. Scott,

I am a victim of a grave injustice as a consequence of Judicial Misconduct, by Judge _____ of the _____ Court. and one of the most heinous circumstances that one could ever imagine. I am not receiving the support that I need from the _____ Court and my situation has become desperate!

Judge _____ displayed judicial misconduct throughout my trial, and was subsequently cited in an article in the Arizona Republic, that he customarily, and consistently victimizes the public by being "indifferent" and "distracted". For example, he conducted a marriage ceremony during my trial.

-He interrupted my trial to conduct an employment hearing

-He was signing documents with his secretary in attendance
