The Supreme Court, having administrative supervision over all courts of the state pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, periodically conducts reviews and audits of court operations.

The Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2001-96 on August 30, 2001, ordering administrative supervision of the Glendale Municipal Court be assumed by the Honorable Colin F. Campbell, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County, until court operational problems identified during the AOC audit were corrected. It was further ordered that Presiding Judge Campbell issue such orders, including assignment of an interim judge, as may be required to ensure the independent and proper operation of the Glendale Municipal Court.

It is the desire of the Supreme Court that Presiding Judge Campbell, or his designee, return administrative control of the Glendale Municipal Court to the Glendale Municipal Court Presiding Judge in light of the court's correction of deficiencies identified in the review and the appointment of the Municipal Court Presiding Judge. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2001-96 is rescinded.
