On June 2, 2003, Administrative Order No. 2003-63 was entered establishing the Committee on Rules of Procedure in Domestic Relations Cases. Initially, the Committee was to submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Arizona Judicial Council in March 2004.

Under Administrative Orders No. 2003-63 and No. 2003-97, members were appointed to the Committee with terms expiring on June 30, 2004. The business of the Committee had not been completed at that time; therefore, under Administrative Order No. 2004-17, the terms of the members previously appointed were extended to December 31, 2004, and the time to enter the final report of the Committee's findings and recommendations was extended to the October 2004 meeting date of the Arizona Judicial Council.

The business of the Committee has not been completed. Therefore, in accordance with Administrative Order No. 2003-63 and Administrative Order No. 2004-17, and after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the report of the findings and recommendations of the Committee on Rules of Procedure in Domestic Relations Cases will be due on or before the March 2005 meeting date of the Arizona Judicial Council and the terms of the members previously appointed will be extended to December 31, 2005.
