In accordance with Rule 50, Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing members of the Attorney Discipline Probable Cause Committee (“Committee”). The Attorney Discipline Probable Cause Committee was created on January 1, 2011. Initially, members were appointed for fixed, staggered terms of either one (1), two (2) or three (3) years. Rule 50 specifies that upon expiration of the initial terms, members may be reappointed for a full three-year term.

On December 2, 2010, by Administrative Order No. 2010-123, attorney members Ella Johnson and Jeffrey Pollitt and public member Donald Manring were appointed to the Committee for an initial one-year term; their terms expire on December 31, 2011. Each of these members is eligible for, and is seeking reappointment to the Committee for a full three-year term. Therefore,
