Pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercises administrative supervision over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

It has come to the Court's attention that the Town of Guadalupe Municipal Court has been without a presiding magistrate since September 2, 2016.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Town of Guadalupe Municipal Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Janet Barton, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County, and Judge Barton shall assign judges pro tempore and other judges as needed to conduct court business.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until a successor assumes duties as Presiding Magistrate of the Town of Guadalupe Municipal Court.
