Arizona Revised Statutes § 25-320(D) requires the Supreme Court to establish guidelines for determining the amount of child support and to conduct a quadrennial review of the guidelines to ensure that their application results in the determination of appropriate child support amounts.

Recent changes to state law increasing minimum wage and new federal regulations necessitate an interim review of the current Child Support Guidelines prior to the 2019 quadrennial review. Therefore,

Pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the Child Support Guidelines Review Committee is established as follows:

- 1. Purpose.** The Committee shall review the impact a higher minimum wage and new federal regulations have on the Child Support Guidelines and make recommendations accordingly to the guidelines and, if needed, the Arizona Rules of Family Law Procedure.
- 2. Membership.** The individuals listed on Appendix A are appointed as members of the Child Support Guidelines Review Committee beginning upon entry of this Order, and ending May 31, 2018. The Chief Justice may appoint additional members as may be necessary.
- 3. Meetings.** Committee meetings shall be scheduled at the discretion of the Committee Chair. All meetings shall comply with the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration § 1-202: Public Meetings.
- 4. Administrative Support.** The Administrative Office of the Courts shall provide staff to assist and support the Committee.

5. **Reports.** The Committee shall submit a final report to the Arizona Judicial Council at the December, 2017 meeting.
